Annex C

Planning and Development Report

Feb 2024

1. Proposed Tremblay Multi-Use Connection (Terminal Avenue to Tremblay LRT Station).

Project has been put on pause until the time when VIA rail redevelops the area as part of the High Frequency Rail (HFR). No timetable yet. The RPCA contacted VIA's HFR team to ensure that community concerns are reflected in the redevelopment plan and to see more information on how the City's work to date might be incorporated into VIA's planning. A February 14 in-person meeting (postponed from February 6) has been scheduled for the RPCA at the VIA Station

2. Alta Vista Transportation Corridor (AVTC) Public Consultation

As the city continues its review and update of Ottawa's Transportation Master Plan(TMP), Councilor Menard's office held a public consultation via Zoom on January 29 discuss the future of the field and park space on Lees Avenue that is identified to be used for a AVTC Link to downtown. Several RPCAmembers attended. A copy of the presentation by City officials will be shared later this month. Virtually everyone who spoke at the meeting agreed with the Councilor that this portion of the AVTC should be removed from the TMP and many also stated that the remainder of the AVTC (south of Smyth) should be removed too. They cited the cost of building the road (including conducting a new Environmental Assessment in a time of tight municipal finances), incompatibility with the City's Climate Emergency and stated desire to increase public transit use and active transportation – as well as the loss of valuable greenspace and community gardens. Councillor Carr, who attended the meeting, expressed concern that removing the southernmost portion of the AVTC from the TMP could lead to residential development in the Corridor. However, it is unclear whether this scenario would actually take place. The RPCA requested copies of any relevant traffic studies conducted after the construction of the AVTC Hospital Link to determine any impacts that this Link road has on vehicular traffic flow and patterns. In addition, Councillor Menard's office agreed to look into the process by which land removed from the TMP could be converted and re-zoned as park land or greenspace.

3. Lansdowne 2.0 Update and January 2025 public consultations

The City is looking to move forward with the \$419 million project this year, which includes a new 5,500-seat event centre to replace the Arena at TD Place and building a new north-side stands for the football stadium. Under the partnership with the Ottawa Sports and Entertainment Group, the City would cover the cost of building the new arena and stadium stands. Concerns have been raised about the affordability of this project and the potential financial risks the City faces in light of budgetary constraints and other priorities. On Monday January 7, 2025, the city issued a tender seeking qualification submissions for general contractors to build Lansdowne 2.0. The closing date for submissions was Feb. 4. Two public information sessions were held to discuss the project

4. CHEO Expansion at 401 Smyth Road A

Comments are being accepted for the Site Plan Control application to expand CHEO hospital with a new 6-storey, 21,993m² wing for medical services under the 1Door4Care project. A tunnel and overhead walkway will connect to the existing hospital. A separate application was also received in late January for a variation to February 12, 2025 RPCA Planning and Development Report permit a new CHEO sign. The RPCA has asked Councilor Carr's office for more information on the visual and lighting impact of this facility on the Riverview Park community and its residents.

5. 451 Smyth Road – University of Ottawa Medical Research Facility

Work is ongoing. This new academic research facility will provide laboratory and office facilities. It is adjacent to the existing Roger Guindon Hall and south of the Ring Road. The move-in is scheduled to begin at the end of 2026 or early 2027. Concerns have been received about the visual impact of this facility, particularly since construction began before consultations on the Site Plan Application for the building. No explanation has been given for why the project began before there was an opportunity for public consultation. The RPCA has asked for more information on how to ensure that minimize light pollution from this new facility is minimized...

6 Update on the former Farmboy building in Trainyards There is activity inside the old Farmboy site next to the LCBO No details currently available on prospective tenants.
